Weathers Receives Emory Medal

PFA Fellow, Dwight “Ronnie” Weathers, DDS, vice chairman for oral pathology and director of the Office of Dental Programs in the School of Medicine at Emory University, received the Emory Medal on October 4. The Medal is the highest University award given exclusively to alumni and recognizes distinguished service to Emory or the alumni association, service to the community, and outstanding professional achievement.

Dr. Herman Elected Academy President



Dr. Wayne Herman, former interim chair of the Department of Oral Diagnosis, has been elected president of the American Academy of Oral Medicine.

The Academy promotes knowledge regarding medical aspects of dentistry. Its focus includes oral mucosal diseases, dental management of medically complex patients and chronic facial pain.

Dr. Herman has been a member of the Academy since 1994, most recently serving on its executive and search committees. A professor of oral diagnosis and oral medicine, he has been a faculty member since 1993. Prior to joining MCG, he retired as a colonel after 26 years of active duty in the U.S. Army Dental Corps.

He is a diplomate of the American Board of Oral Medicine and a fellow of the Hinman Dental Society and the Pierre Fauchard Academy. In 2001, Dr. Herman received the School of Dentistry Outstanding Faculty and Teaching Excellence awards. He is the School of Dentistry’s faculty represen-

tative to the American Dental Education Association and one of the school’s four representatives to the association’s Commission of Change American and Georgia Dental Associations and the Eastern District Dental Society. Dr. Herman earned his dental degree from Indiana University in 1967 and a master’s degree in oral diagnosis from the University of Iowa in 1974.

Dr. Carroll, Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry’s Distinguished Alumnus

Dr. Clark M. Carroll, a general dentist in Eastman, GA, has been named the 2007 School of Dentistry Distinguished Alumnus. The award was presented by the School of Dentistry Alumni Association during MCG’s homecoming celebration April 26-28. Dr. Carroll graduated from MCG in 1974 at age 21 after gaining early admission at age 18. He was admitted to Middle Georgia College at age 16.

Dr. Carroll, who has practiced in Eastman since graduation, is president of the Georgia Board of Dentistry and a member of the board of directors of the Southern Regional Testing Agency, the Steering Committee of the Central Regional Dental Testing Service, the American Association of Dental Examiners, the American Dental Association and the Academy of General Dentistry. He is an honorable fellow of the Georgia Dental Association and a former two-term president of the Central District Dental Society.

Weinman Named NDDS Dentist of the Year

PFA Fellow Richard A. Weinman, DMD, a general dentist in Atlanta, was named the Northern District Dental Society’s Michael T. Rainwater Dentist of the Year during the Gala for Smiles event August 25 at the Georgia Aquarium. 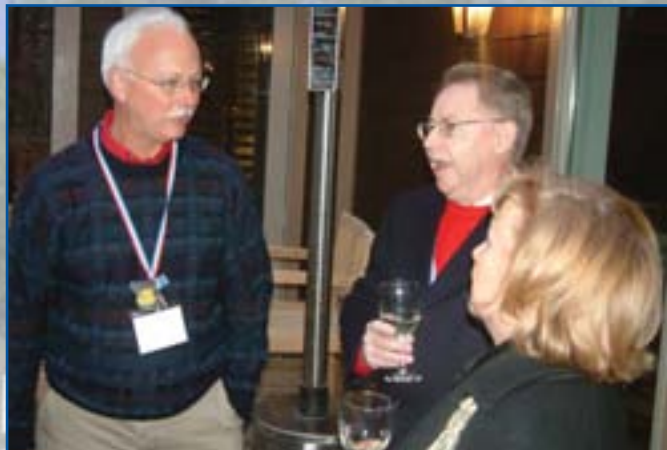
